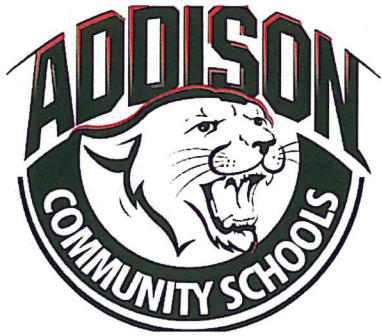

ANOTHER GREAT WEEK!

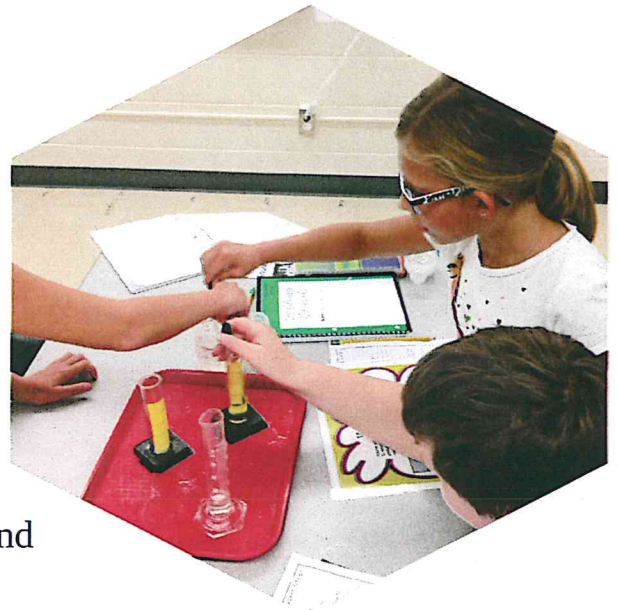
We had awesome school spirit this week! It was fun to see students dress up for each day. Go Panthers!

Literacy: Spelling words with long and short /e/ sounds, story structure, and summarizing. We also started our first writing project.



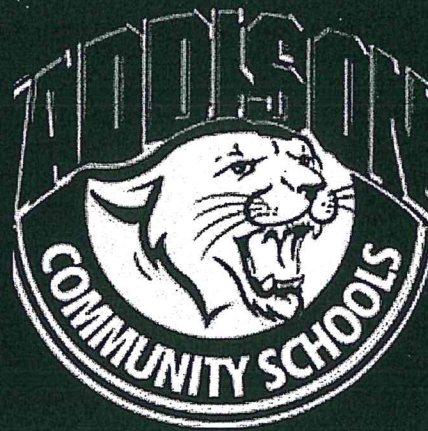

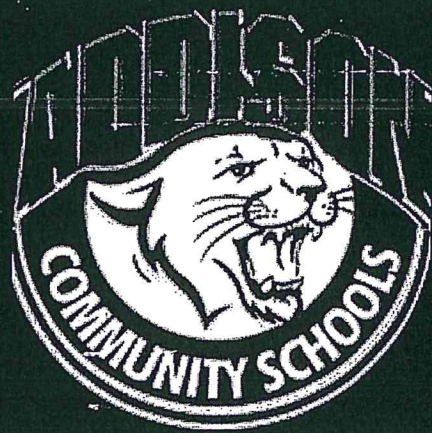
